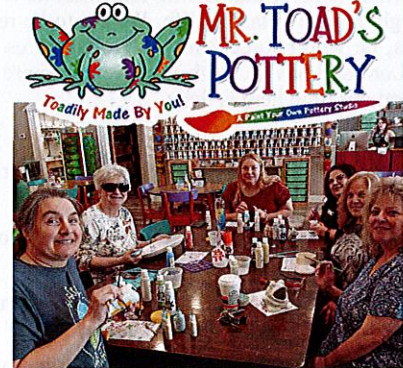

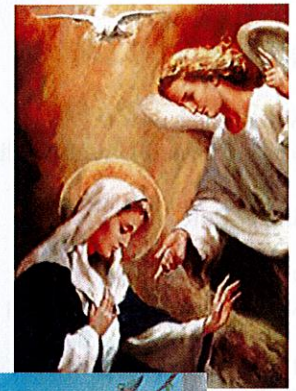

Hello everyone, I hope all of you had a good week and a good Memorial Day weekend, even if it was a bit on the wet side. Here at the rectory, we had about 3.5" of rain over the course of a few days, and I'm sure it put a damper on the weekend activities unless there were mud races or mud wrestling involved.

This weekend at St. Anthony's, we will have a finance/parish council meeting after church. I know it's been a while, and I do apologize. For Annunciation, look for one for both councils in June. I know some of the parish council's new members are antsy to have one soon, but just be patient with me as I look ahead to see when a viable day is, date & time. Thank you.

I want to thank all of you who helped decorate for the Easter season and take down to prepare to get back to Ordinary time; it is very much appreciated.

This weekend, we look at the Trinity. "O, Most Holy Trinity, undivided unity..." The thereness of God is a relationship between the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. And this relationship is founded on love. So, we see in 1 John 4:8, our author says: "God is love." We have heard this many times over, but it bears repeating over and over again. Some of us are hardheaded, or we have put up a wall to God, and so we should repeat it as often as we can. It may seem repetitive to keep saying it, but how many of us tell our spouses, children, and grandchildren we love them? Do they get tired of hearing it? I would surmise they don't. As humans, we desire to be loved. And the most perfect and undeniable way is the love that God has for us.

Almost all religions in the world start with the premise that God is good. But how many of them believe that God is the one searching for them and not the other way around, humanity searching for God? Christianity is the one faith that God searches for us. Of course, God knows where we are; he knows everything about us, and he created us. But he wants us to be open to him and invite him into our lives. He knocks at our hearts; in that way, in a sense, he searches for us.

When Jesus came to earth, he did so to rescue the fallen human race from evil and restore us to our rightful place and to a right relationship with God. And so with that, we see the infinite power of God's love and his revelation to us through his son, who gave his life for us. By Christ's death, we are redeemed. And so God's fundamental characteristic is love, that is who and what he is at the very core.: For God so loved the world that we might have everlasting life. We are to be reunited with our maker; if we accept him into our lives, he won't force himself. He wants us to freely love him in return for accepting his Son as our Lord and Savior. With that, we can share in the life of God forever in our true and eternal home when our time here is done.
