From the desk of Fr. Dan

Hello all. Hope you've had a great week. We had a little tease of warmer weather earlier in the week, and it looks like this week we can get some more teasing from Mother Nature. I know a lot of us are ready for Spring and a few might be ready for summer.

As has been noted previously, we begin Lent on Wednesday this week; the 18th with Ash Wednesday and Stations of the Cross on Friday the 20th.

On Saturday, the 21st, at 4:30 PM Mass, we will have **two** Baptisms! What a joy it will be for each family as they see their little one baptized into the Christian family and into the Catholic faith. I want to share something with you from an article about Pope Leo XIV when he baptized 20 children on January 11th, the Baptism of the Lord. Some of his quotes were on the significance of the sacrament. It's a good reminder for all of us about our own baptism and the meaning it has for us as Christians. By the way, he baptized them in the Sistine Chapel. How cool is that? He says: "Just as we wouldn't leave newborns without clothes or food, we cannot leave them without faith and baptism." He continues: "Just as they received life from you, parents, so now they receive the meaning to live it: faith." May our little ones who will receive the light of Christ in the font of baptism live a life of faith. They should be examples of Christ to others as they grow and mature in their faith, just as their parents, godparents, their families and all of us are examples of Jesus to them.

Here we go; buckle up:

I've finally reached my wonder years: I wonder where I left my phone, wonder where my glasses went, and wonder what day it is.

Here is some sound advice: A dad to a son, "Always be decisive, son." "Why's that dad?" "Because the road of life is paved with flat squirrels who couldn't make a decision."

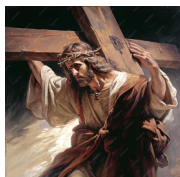
