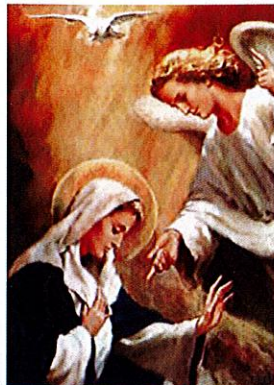

A few things coming up within the next couple of months:
