Together, we are building a stronger, more compassionate Church that **lives out the Gospel in word and deed**. I humbly invite you to join me in this mission.

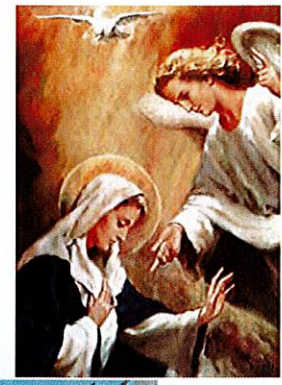

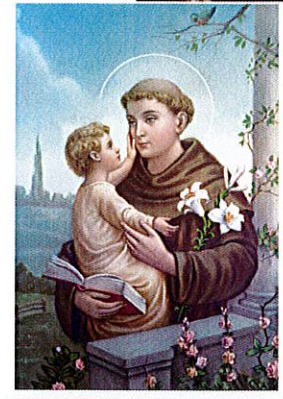
