On Sat. May 16th, the Cumberland Historic Cemetery Organization and St. Anthony's parishioners unveiled a CHCO designated and protected monument for founding priest Fr. Robert J. Kilgannon. Born in Ireland in 1893, he became pastor in 1922 until his death in 1968. He was a traditional conservative Holy priest and lead many to the priesthood through his example. He and the organization spearheaded a project to erect a headstone/monument for the founding pastor of St. Anthony's, Fr. Robert J. Kilgannon. I've written about him before in the bulletin. Fr. Kilgannon only had a flat stone at St. Mary's Cemetery on Uhl Highway, and it was a travesty not to have a headstone for him. Although he has been gone from us since 1968, there are still a few parishioners who remember him and do so fondly. I had the honor of saying a few words about him.
