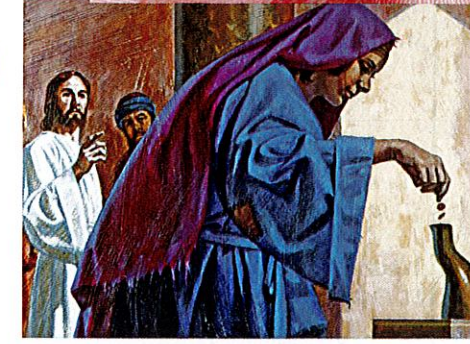

"With the kids jingle belling and everyone telling you be of good cheer..." What about the Christmas movies and TV specials that we all love to watch that take us, well at least me, back to my childhood. How about *It's A Wonderful Life*, *Miracle on 34th Street*, *A Christmas Carol*, *Rudolph the Red-Nosed Reindeer*, and so many more, including the *Andy Williams Christmas Specials*. And the Christmas music, great times! I just slapped myself to bring me back to reality. It's only the beginning of November, what's wrong with me?!

Anyhow, a few months back I mentioned in the bulletin that there might be some members of the Parish Pastoral and Finance councils who might like to come off and allow others to take their place to continue to help me plan out the future of our two churches so that they can be vibrant beacons of Christ's light for years to come.

Pastoral Council: help me with long-range planning in matters pertaining to the life of the parish. This will entail a variety of subjects, such as fundraising and planning for various functions, basically if it pertains the life of the parish then we discuss it. I'm looking for those who have the desire to serve their parish home in a unique way by serving their fellow parishioners.

Finance Council: help me plan with long-range planning of our finances and how best to utilize what we have. They help with the financial matters pertaining to the budget, facilities and development.

Last week I mentioned the new evangelization method the diocese has adopted from the Catholic Leadership Institute; the program is called "Called for More." As part of this initiative, there needs to be a parish point of contact person for each parish. Any takers? Basically, you will be the liaison between the diocese and the parish. You'll share information and should be comfortable with modern technology, i.e., internet, computers, cell phones, etc. The point person will share information with the parish about the DMI (Disciple Maker Index [a survey conducted by this company]). Also, you will provide the diocese with various bits of information on the parish relative to this initiative. The time commitment is supposed to be around 2-4 hours a month, but will include more time in the beginning, 1-2 hours a week, as this gets up and running. This person will have to attend an orientation webinar to help them get started and understand the process. If this is of interest to anyone, please let me or the office know. I'll need one person from each parish. Volunteering for this will mean your reward will be great in heaven. Please pray about it! Thank you.
