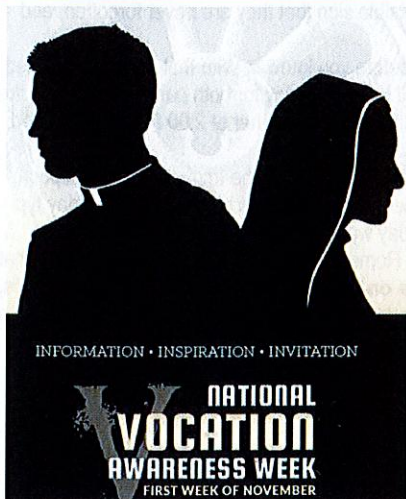

From the Desk of Fr. Dan

Happy November to all of you. Where has the time gone? It just seemed like yesterday that we were sweltering under the summer sun, and the grass was brown as the Arizona desert. Here we are, entering November; the holiday season is right around the corner. Some things to keep you up to date on the happenings at both locations.

As you know, we have started an adult continuing faith education video class by Dr. Edward Sri titled, *Into His Likeness; Be Transformed as a Disciple of Christ*. Come on out and see how we can be transformed into his likeness every Wednesday at 2:00 PM until November 27th. There are no tests to endure; no attendance is taken. If this goes well, I will offer it again in the evening at a later date.

Thanksgiving is coming up later this month. As in the past, we will have Mass at 9:00 AM at Annunciation and 11:00 AM at St. Anthony's. There will be no Friday morning Mass at Annunciation as I will be away visiting my folks in Berkeley Springs.

Also, this month we recognize and remember our beloved dead as we pray in a special way for them all month. The Book of Remembrance is out so that we have a visible sign that they are never forgotten, and they are in the arms of God.

I know that December seems far away, but it will be here before you know it. With that in mind, let's step into the month of December briefly. Sunday December 8th will be a great day for both parishes as this is the day we come together and have a party, a Christmas party that is! We will gather at 2:00 PM for good food, fun and fellowship. Please bring your favorite culinary delight and yourselves.

The next day, Monday the 9th, is interesting. December 8th is the Feast of the Immaculate Conception, but since it falls on a Sunday during Advent this year, it has been moved to Monday. In the past, a day typically a holy day of obligation that fell on a Monday or a Saturday was no longer a holy day of obligation. However, the US bishops conference appealed to Rome and Rome told them it will be for this year. So, that means that **it is a Holy Day of Obligation** for this year. **Mass on Monday the 9th will be at St. Anthony's, 12 noon, and 6:00 PM at Annunciation.** Will this set a precedent for future HDO's that fall on a Saturday or a Monday? Who knows? Will this mean that the HDO's that have been moved off their traditional days, and are moved to the following Sunday, be moved back to their traditional days? Again, who knows.

I want to inform you of "an exciting initiative that promises to shape our Diocese in a meaningful way." This is how Bishop Brennan addressed us in his letter about the Catholic Leadership Institute's 3-year plan for evangelization. There is a survey involved with this whereby parishioners are to reflect on their faith journey. The bishop says this will be invaluable in helping the diocese better serve us and the whole diocese. If you're wondering about me, have no fear, I must take a survey too, just geared towards the priests. As the bishop says in his letter, it will be "a comprehensive assessment designed to foster individual development within our clergy." There's more. There will be one-on-one interviews with a small number of parishioners to help gather diverse perspectives "to ensure that the final outcomes resonate with our entire diocesan family." He says this effort is not to close parishes, but to revitalize and grow the Catholic footprint in the diocese. Like the initiative with the Year of the Eucharist, the diocese is requesting a point of contact person who will be a liaison between the parish and the diocese. As I write this, I don't know all the details. By the time you read this I will have been to a ZOOM meeting. Hopefully, it gave me more insight as to what this will really mean for us at Annunciation and St. Anthony's. Stay tuned.
