From the Desk of Fr. Dan

Groeten (Dutch for "Greetings"): Hope all of you had a good week and recovered from the time change. Did it mess up your internal systems? It did mine a bit.

I want to continue this week our topic of prayer from a couple weeks ago. I'm sure all of us have seen a pirate movie or two and the stereotypical pirate response of, "*Arrrr, Matey.*" Well guess what? Prayer is a bit of an "arr" as well. ARRR comes from our prayer class that finished a couple of weeks ago. It stands for:

A-cknowledge R-elate R-eceive R-espond ARRR!

Acknowledge: "God calls man first. Man may forget his Creator or hide far from his face; he may run after idols or accuse the deity of having abandoned him; yet the living and true God tirelessly calls each person to that mysterious encounter known as prayer. In prayer ... God's initiative of love always comes first; our own first step is always a response." (CCC, 2567)

Relate: "Where does prayer come from? Whether prayer is expressed in words or gestures, it is the whole man, who prays. In naming the source of prayer, Scripture speaks sometimes of the soul or the spirit, but most often of the heart (more than a thousand times). According to Scripture, it is the heart that prays. If our heart is far from God, the words of prayer are in vain." (CCC, 2562) Tips for "Relating" to God: Don't just think about God; talk to God. Be aware. Be honest. Nothing is "off limits." Remember Psalm 139:4 (RSV:CE). "Even before a word is on my tongue, behold, O Lord, you know it altogether."

Receive: "God speaks in silence, but we must know how to listen." (Pope Benedict XVI) Tips for "Receiving" from God: Listen. Listen with all your spiritual senses. Be patient. Don't be afraid of the silence. Could be a voice... a song... a memory... an image... a sensation in your body... a Scripture passage.

Respond: After listening with our whole spiritual self, then we respond to God. Tips for "Responding" to God:

Respond to what you have received. Could be more conversation... question... laughter... tears... "yes." Together, the four steps of relational prayer (A.R.R.R.) are a vibrant dynamic, not a systematic checklist.

This is taken from the workbook for the course. I hope this was helpful to you if you're going through a dry patch in your prayer life, as we all do.

Here we go:

Them: What's the biggest parenting lesson you've learned? Parents: That no matter how overwhelmed you are, there's always room to be even more overwhelmed.

How do you console an English teacher? There, their, they're.

Dad: Doctor, my son ate a few electrical cords. What should I do? Doctor: Ground him until he conducts himself properly.
