

Hello, hello, hello! I hope all of you had a wonderful Easter with family, good food, and, of course, celebrating the Risen Lord! "Amen," and "Yes, Jesus!"

I want to thank all of you who helped get the churches beautified for Holy Week and Easter. They both look wonderful! A lot of time and work went into getting both our churches ready. All of you did a fantastic job; give yourselves a pat on the back. I also, want to thank all of you for your kind Easter wishes, as well as the cards, gifts, and green holy cards I received. Many, many thanks, y'all are very generous so thank you again from the bottom of my heart.

Now that we are in post-Easter time, maybe we can talk baseball. More specifically, Altoona Curve baseball. We have the tickets, and we have a list of those who signed up. On that first Divine Mercy Sunday, Pope John Paul II said: "Jesus said to St. Faustina one day: 'Humanity will never find peace until it turns with trust to 'Divine Mercy.' Divine Mercy! This is the Easter gift that the Church receives from the risen Christ and offers it to humanity.'" This devotion has grown rapidly over the decades, even before the official designation for the second Sunday of Easter, but it certainly has really accelerated since then. Pope Francis says that Jesus is the face of the Father's mercy. May all of us know deep within us of this outpouring of God's mercy to us.
