




back as the 4th or 5th century, this falls nine months before the Feast of the Nativity of the Lord. The Annunciation recalls the day when

Judy Wolfe has sponsored a vigil candle at St. Anthony's for the month of April in loving memory of Andrew Wolfe.












THE CHAPLET OF DIVINE MERCY

(For private recitation on ordinary rosary beads)

Our Father, Hail Mary, the Apostles' Creed

Then, on the Our Father beads say the following words: "Eternal Father, I offer You the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your dearly beloved Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world."

On the Hail Mary Beads say the following words: "For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world." In conclusion three times recite these words: "Holy God, Holy Mighty One. Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world."



Hello, hello, hello! I hope all of you had a wonderful Easter with family, good food, and, of course, celebrating the Risen Lord! "Amen," and "Yes, Jesus!"
