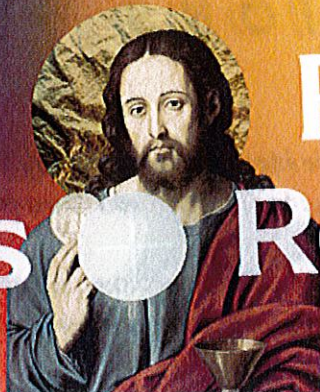

VIRTUAL OR IN-PERSON ACTIVITY SUGGESTIONS

...for youth

Pinwheels are a symbol for innocence and joy. The color blue is a symbol of hope and heavenly grace. Incorporate a blue pinwheel into craft or other activities.

Ideas: Create a pinwheel with sculpting clay, construction paper or paint. Variation: on each blade write a message of affirmation to a child. Make pinwheel cookies or decorate cupcakes with blue icing.

...for community

Host a speaker event in-person or virtually. Possible Topics: identification of signs of abuse, tips for parents, invite a speaker from a local shelter or youth service organization.

Launch a messaging campaign - interview local prevention specialist for diocesan/parish print or web-based recordings, post messages on social media, include contact information for hotlines and other assistance services.

...for CYP leaders

Meet with diocesan staff
